Purpose: Fellowship

Outreach / Fellowship / Discipleship

Pizza - hotdogs – burgers... or what have ya!

This can be a budget cruncher so bring in the adults Sunday school class for help

Game Idea –

Webbed Cocoon: Have a team (or teams) of students use their webbing capabilities to store their victim to the wall for later nourishment.

(in other words. Duct tape them to the wall.)

Students pick lightest member and stand him on a chair against the wall. When team has victim in its web, they remove the chair and time how long victim hangs without falling. Good stuff, *although there have been reports on the internet of serious injury or even death with this game, so please be careful and we felt like you should be warned!*

Safe Event for bringing friends

If students know it's gonna be fun, and you're not gonna crank out an in depth study on Leviticus. And of course Food always helps.

Remember: Fun is ok! You don't have to pack in a sermon, missions offering, and testimonies about choir tour into this. Keep it simple.

Costumes: The challenge to the students and your workers is that every student would wear outfits made of duct tape to church that night. They can start with normal clothes and layer them with duct tape and create some great fashions.

Show some examples of fashion on the nights before your event to get their creative juices flowing.

Decoration: Prep time for this event can be priceless fellowship time with your adults and parents. During this time, you will be able to get to know parents and see what they're like in a servant setting. Hmmmm... future workers perhaps?

Just make sure you have the tasks spelled out with all the tools necessary before they get there. They are not teenagers ... They'll only sit around for so long.

Ideas: Set up rooms of furniture in your youth area covered in duct tape.

1. Dining Room
2. Living Room
3. Bathroom (tee hee)
4. Bedroom

This would be great for photo opportunities.

Church members should have furniture sitting in the garage that would be a great help to your outreach!
